Help Kirkwood Public Library cut the ribbon at our new home in Station Plaza, 200 South Kirkwood Road, on Wednesday, May 20, at 4 PM.

Everyone is welcome to join us as we dedicate our new space. An Open House will follow the ceremony, so enjoy refreshments and bring your appetite for a good book. From Summer Reading events to passports, the library will continue to offer a full slate of services.

While the 1939 building at 140 East Jefferson is being remodeled for approximately 12 to 18 months, the library will operate from the Station Plaza location. Randall Miltenberger, President of the Library Board of Trustees, says the library is working hard “to retain the historic character of the building.”

Patrons will find ample parking in the two parking garages, as well as a lot dedicated to the library on Monroe Avenue just south of the building.
